## FROM FATHER PHONG

The three seminarians are here for the summer months. They were picked up at Logan and safely arrived at the rectory. Joseph Ha, Matthew Tuan and Joseph Hien. They had just completed the second year of theology from the St. Meinrad Seminary of Indiana. They looked very tired not only from the long flight but from weeks of writing final papers and preparing for exams. Since I was occupied with a funeral, a few parishioners volunteered themselves to prepare a lunch reception. Unfamiliar with the surrounding, Joseph Ha right away bumped his head rather hard against a corner of a cabinet and drew some blood. The ensuing fantastic lunch hopefully took some pain away. After lunch, I asked them to get unpacked and a nap.

It is really good to have them here with me. I have been their mentor since their arrival upon the soil of America, leaving behind their family, classmates, friends and cultural familiarities. With a sacred mission to study, be trained and prepare themselves to become future seminary professors of philosophy and theology. They have not seen their family and friends for more than five years now, and had missed quite a few births of their nieces and nephews as well as funerals of their grandparents, aunts and uncles. I promise them that I shall see to it that they be able to physically embrace their parents, brothers and sisters, friends and classmates by next summer.

I am not frustrated any longer because I have to wear a mask!

## A FEW PARISH-KEEPING ITEMS:

Please have your children registered for the **Faith Formation Program 2021-2022**. I call attention especially to the parents of children whose reception of First Reconciliation and First Communion were delayed during this pandemic year to quickly enlist them for the July Sacramental Program.

The staff and I are working on the **census/registration form for our parish**. We need to generate a somewhat realistic data of our parish. So much had changed. Members moving out and entering in and these transitions necessitate an update. Please help us with your prompt response.

We just got the permit from the city allowing **our kitchen** - with some minor adjustments - to operate with preparing and selling food. This is one of the many plans to raise extra funds for our parish. At this time, the kitchen would be open on Sunday mornings and we will start with only carry-outs.

The owner of **Yoki, a Japanese Sushi and Bar Restaurant**, has approached me with a wonderful idea. Yes, he is a parishioner and is well aware of our financial difficulty. He will be bringing to the office a stack of gift cards for you all to purchase. Thirty percent (30%) of the transaction will be donated to the parish.

These are the **activities at the gym** on weekends. On Saturdays, Vovinam - a form of martial arts originated from Vietnam - is holding classes from 1:00-4:00 P.M. A group of young men and women are playing volleyball from 5:00-8:00 P.M. On Sunday afternoons, the Viet Eucharistic Movement will use the gym from 1:00-3:30 P.M. A couple who are Aikido masters have expressed interest in offering classes here at Saint Clements. I am hoping in the future, we will be able to have basketball and soccer as well as Zumba or any type of aerobics to join us. Any takers???

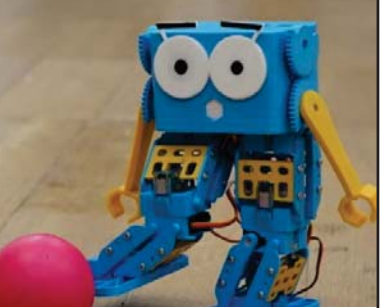
