I lost my voice. Restlessness and overuse of the vocal cords during the Holy Week did that. So it is good that I am going away. Right now, I am sitting here at Paris' Charles de Galle airport. France colonized Vietnam in the early 20th century with ruthlessness and inhumanity. So growing up I refused to learn French. But English is understood here. My connecting flight to Rome is not scheduled to depart for another 5 hours. Unfortunately, the tiny terminal has lots of shops but only three cafes. A bottle of water - probably tap water - is priced close to 6 dollars. Although the quiches look mightily scrumptious and very tempting. But the price tag quickly made the decision for me. Ain't no quiche slice worth my 12 bucks.

I am also very sleepy. I was placed next to a lady who never sat still. She hogged the arm rest. And her long coat draped over my seat. I managed nonetheless to watch a documentary of a mother bear raising her two cubs. I was touched by the mother's passionate protection and care. Perhaps this mother bear's heart resembles a bit better to the heart of God than ours.

I will be occupied with attending seminars and lectures on this Divine Mercy weekend. The seminars probably would be conducted in English. But the lectures from the Cardinal prefect of the papal missionaries of mercy will be in Italian. Thank God for the simultaneous translation. At some point during the weekend, we are asked to hear confessions. The Pope will meet us on Monday. If his health permits, maybe we would be allowed to come touch his hand. Let me tell you, he has the kindest set of eyes. Yes, we are also organized for private tours of the Sistine Chapel, the Tombs, and some great churches. I have signed up for all the offered tours. But these are my top three priorities while in Rome: to touch and hold the hands of Pope Francis, to rest, and to eat - pasta carbonara, pizza with Italian sausage and tiramisu. And I shall walk the Vatican cobbled streets to burn off the caloric intake.

Fr. Nghia Cao is a friend. I heard of his work with the indigenous poor and neglected who live in the isolated mountainous region of Vietnam. I reached out to him. Then I enlisted him to join Cross Catholic Outreach. I was at the time a preacher for this fantastic charitable organization and thought that Fr. Cao's witness and dedication to the poor would make a very passionate plea on their behalf. He joined. And he was and is powerful.

So please pay close attention to his words and most especially his heart. Give him a warm welcome. And do try your best in supporting his ministry and the works of Cross Catholic Outreach.

Some future dates you may want to mark down on your calendar. First Reconciliation on May 7. First Communion on Mother's Day, May 8. Ordination to the Diaconate of seminarians Ha, Tuan and Hien on May 22. Confirmation is on May 29. A Parish Picnic, perhaps at a park, is being anticipated on a Sunday near the feast of Blessed Andrew Phu-Yen, toward the end of July.

I am hungry. I may need to swallow my stinginess and purchase that slice of quiche.

Be holy. Therefore, be merciful. I shall be lifting up the entire parish family at every church that I enter.
