## FROM FATHER PHONG

Yesterday I received a text from a dear friend from Grand Rapids, MI - my former seminary rector, my spiritual guide and confessor. I called him and was told that a mutual acquaintance and a very good and beautiful young priest just left the priesthood. He is in love and desires to serve God and the church as a married man. When he was a seminarian, from time to time he would show up at my parish for the morning mass. After mass we usually had a small talk. I really liked him and was extremely happy when he was called and ordained to the priesthood. And he was a very good priest and pastor. Gentle, compassionate and a great listener.

“Two roads diverged in a wood, and I—  
I took the one less traveled by,  
And that has made all the difference.”

From time to time, I thanked Mr. Frost for laying the angst of our hearts bare for everyone to see. However, must our lives be, although disjointed, dotted lines of “what ifs”? Must we spend our quiet solitude drowned in regrets, in the yesterdays, in looking back? No, we mustn’t. Permit me then to introduce the sage, Father Merton.

“My Lord God,  
I have no idea where I am going.  
I do not see the road ahead of me.  
I cannot know for certain where it will end,  
nor do I really know myself,  
and the fact that I think I am following your will  
does not mean that I am actually doing so.  
But I believe that the desire to please you  
does in fact please you.  
And I hope I have that desire in all that I am doing.  
I hope that I will never do anything apart from that desire.  
And I know that if I do this you will lead me by the right road,  
though I may know nothing about it.  
Therefore will I trust you always though  
I may seem to be lost and in the shadow of death.  
I will not fear, for you are ever with me,  
and you will never leave me to face my perils alone.”

I am a pessimist by nature and have swum and waded through thousands and thousands of miles against the currents and waves of my self just to get to the middle. I believe that I am now there. For most of the times I could distinguish clearly between the yin and yang and between the do’s and the do not’s. But whether I had acted or had chosen the correct paths is another subject of contention. But Merton’s conviction that God “will never leave me to face my perils alone” is the greatest of assurances. Indeed, God will never abandon us humanity.

Shall we, this week, not do the contrary? Shall we, just for this week, pull the immigrants, the refugees, the straights and the gays and the lesbians, the Italians, the Irish, the Vietnamese, the Portuguese - in fact, everyone and every creature on the face of this wonderful planet - a bit closer to our heart? Let’s be, just for the seven days of this week, authentic and credible and existential Christians.
